



2019 is going looking to be a great year

After sitting down with management and staff at our local hospitals, we have determined the needs for our 2019/2020 year. We are excited for the upcoming projects and the great changes they will bring to each of the hospitals in the Eastern Fraser Valley.

Abbotsford Regional Hospital and Cancer Centre is a 295-bed health care facility that houses the acute care Abbotsford Regional Hospital (ARH) operated by Fraser Health, and the regional cancer facility operated by the BC Cancer Agency. The ARH Emergency Department (ED) sees over 44,000 patients annually, and is in particular need of support.

Cottage Worthington is a long-term seniors care facilities, for individuals who can no longer live independently at home due to complex health care needs and require 24-hour nursing care in a secure environment. Help support seniors in long-term care facilities live their best lives.



Opened in 1965, **Mission Memorial Hospital** is a community hospital that provides primary acute care services, including an Emergency Room that operates 24 hours a day/7 days a week, an Inpatient Medical Unit and Ambulatory Day Care, as well as laboratory and medical imaging services, four outpatient clinics and a Patient Assessment and Transition to Home unit, which eases congestion at neighbouring hospitals. In 2017, Mission Memorial Hospital saw 22,611 Emergency Room visits, provided care to 1,302 acute inpatients and experienced 48,170 visits to ambulatory care.



With 148 acute care beds, **Chilliwack General Hospital** serves the communities of Chilliwack, Hope, Agassiz and Harrison Hot Springs, and provides primary care, core secondary and some specialty services, including an Emergency Room that operates 24 hours a day/7 days a week, Acute Care, General and Internal Medicine, Coronary Care, Obstetrics, medical imaging, general surgery and certain surgical subspecialties, such as eye surgery. In 2017, Chilliwack General Hospital saw 55,029 Emergency Room visits, provided care to 8,471 inpatients, performed 10,465 day surgeries, delivered 824 babies and experienced 112,913 visits to ambulatory care.



Opened in 1959, **Fraser Canyon Hospital** is a 10-bed community hospital located in Hope, providing emergency care stabilization and triage 24 hours a day/7 days a week, which is a critical service due to its geographic isolation and the large volume of vehicles that converge in the area via several major highways. There is also general medicine, medical imaging and ambulatory care services, supported by an integrated network of community-based programs and services, ranging from health promotion and prevention to residential and hospice care. In 2017, Fraser Canyon Hospital saw 11,504 Emergency Room visits, provided care to 502 inpatients and experienced 15,672 visits to ambulatory care.

Did you know that every year in British Columbia, the Drug and Poison Information Centre receives 26,000 calls about poisoning, including almost 4,000 drug poisoning cases that require hospitalization, and approximately 500 of which are fatal . A quarter of these serious cases occur among adults aged 55 and over.

We have teamed up with The Community Against Preventable Injuries and London Drugs to raise awareness among seniors about the importance of knowing and tracking all their medications to reduce preventable overdoses and dangerous side effects when some medications are mixed - including over-the-counter drugs.
